## Stained Glass Window Dedication Delayed

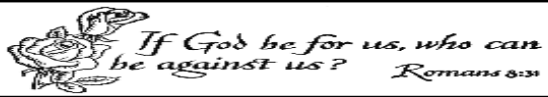
