About the Crucifix:

Above the Altar is a figure of the redeeming Christ, the Crucified Savior. It is, however, the victory of the cross that redeems, and in this figurative symbol, the act of atonement is projected with a glimpse of conquest. Christ is nailed to the tree but not overcome by it. His body assumes the form of the cross just as He allowed Himself to be satisfaction for the sins of many. His head is bowed, not in anguish, but in compassion for the sons of men. His face shows no torment, but the intent of love. His right hand forms the sign of blessing around an accursed nail.

School Resumes in August


