

Closer Look: PULPIT

The sermon each week is delivered from a pulpit designed to emphasize the power of God's word. The supporting bars beneath it are shaped in the form of the cross which, at the base, form the traditional symbol of the four Evangelists. The reference here is to the written Word and the preaching ministry of the church. This emphasis is echoed by the pulpit hangings which are in the form of the stole, the most ancient symbol of Christian teachers. Behind the pulpit is attached the processional cross, which can be seen above the preacher. As with St. Paul, we are to preach Christ, and him crucified for the forgiveness of our sins.

Bringing Light to Darkness


