## **Immanuel Staff Reports**

## **Highlights-From the Pastors**

2020 proved to be a time for adaptation in response to the pandemic environment starting in March. We ap-• preciate the unity, patience, and faithfulness of our members all year! Here are a few highlights to share: •

- Our 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary saw a strong kick-off with Dr. Dale Meyer 0202-2020. All remaining events
   were eventually postponed to 2021
- Worship services moved to virtual only from mid-March to mid-May, including Holy Week and Easter. Previous investments in media platforms positioned us to keep in touch with members virtually, with record-setting numbers logged.
- Immanuel staff recorded numerous chapters of seasonal favorite hymns posted online.
- Sanitizing stations were installed in church and adjustments made to seating, Communion distribution, offering, and face-coverings to prepare for in-person worship resumption
- Immanuel Lutheran School went to distance learning the entire 4<sup>th</sup> quarter. Classroom cameras • were added to allow students to engage live in the classroom in the fall if they were absent.
- Confirmation and Questioning were postponed until June but were conducted in-person with students and families.
- Our Child Care Ministry was closed in April and May following protocols coordinated with the local health department and state and reopened in June.
- Immanuel applied for and received Payroll Protection Plan loans that allowed childcare and school
  workers to receive regular pay throughout the shut -down periods.
- Members made and donated countless face coverings for use at Schneck, nursing homes, as well as at church and school.
- We partnered with the community to receive donations of food to be distributed to families in need in cooperation with Schneck.
- We provided more than 100 meals each Sunday night for 8 weeks through May and June to be given out to those in need.
- The final sessions of photos for the new directory
  were cancelled. Local photographers were engaged to complete and submit pictures.
- An updated, illustrated history of Immanuel was submitted for a book to be available in early 2021.
- Our Virtual VBS was so well received that it was shared around the Indiana District and Synod.
- Resources for Sunday School and Bible Studies were placed online.
- Our Youth ministry used social media platforms

to keep engaged with our youth.

- The ILS Fellowship Golf outing was cancelled, but donors raised nearly the same funds as before.
- The Annual ILS Fish Fry was conducted as a drive-through event, raising record profits.
- ILS successfully prepared for in-person classes starting in August, and the fall semester went well.
- Even without the Fair Stand and Oktoberfest, Immanuel members gave faithfully so that we ended the fiscal year without a deficit.
- Several blood drives were held successfully to replenish Red Cross supplies.
- Help for the needy was arranged through gift cards instead of baskets.
- Our Safety and Security Task Force made investments in cameras, training, and equipment to provide extra safety for worshippers.
- Due to growing demand, a 3<sup>rd</sup> infant room was approved and prepared for opening in early 2021.
- A power-assisted door was added to the near the Child Care entrance, new flooring for the Child Care area, and 1995 HVAC units replaced.
- The Property Board resolved leak issues on the north and east sides, replaced landscaping, and painted the east side exterior and atrium.
- Windows in the sanctuary were replaced with insulated glass, unused registers were replaced with stone veneer, three historic windows were relocated to the Chapel and Narthex, and two of six new bays of windows were installed.
- ILS conducted Christmas concerts without audiences, recording them so that families, friends, and members could watch them online.
- A Live Nativity was conducted as a drive-through event, with hundreds of cars passing by.
- ILS Children were divided into two groups alphabetically to present two Christmas Eve services at 4:30 and 6 instead of one at 7.
- A 150<sup>th</sup> +1 anniversary wall calendar was prepared by the anniversary committee and printed and sent to members through a grant from the Foundation
- Financial Peace University classes assisted many individuals and families
- We said goodbye to Vicar Kyle Ronchetto and welcomed Will and Charlea Fredstrom.
- Additional Communion visits were provided for those not ready to return to worship

We look forward to what God has in store for us in the year of our Lord 2021!


## 2020 Immanuel Children's Ministry



**Sunday School** did meet in-person for the first part of the year, reopened in August for just a few weeks before closing again due to the spread of COVID-19 in Jackson County. Online resources including weekly recorded Online Sunday School lessons were taught by teachers and made available online for families to access at home.



A Digital Vacation Bible School was held in June and was certainly like no VBS ever held before. The entire Virtual VBS program including opening and closing as well as craft and snack activities were recorded and put together as one single video per day. Children and families were able to pick up a packet of materials and participate at home through recordings presented in the online format via the Immanuel website and YouTube. Immanuel ministry staff and volunteers worked closely with the Pastors and congregations from both Redeemer and Zion to make and present the Virtual VBS.



**Mid-Week Lenten Adventure Activities** were held inperson until COVID-19 forced us to cancel this weekly event. An online only Children and Family Good Friday Service was held. "The Way of the Cross" coloring book was presented as part of the service and allowed for children and families to color and participate in the service together online from home.



**Midweek Advent Activities** offered children grab and go "Hope and Healing Activity Kits" as well as an online recorded devotion that led the children through a creative project. The kit was designed to be fun, full of learning, and give families with children the opportunity to share with each other, and also with a friend or neighbor, the love of Christ during the season of Advent.



**Women's BIBLE Study** finished up their study of Romans during the Winter months and then held an online discussion and reading of the book "Lady Like." In person classes were held from August – November and included an intense study of "Luther's Small Catechism – A Manuel for Discipleship." The fall quarter class was led by Patti Miller and Michelle Downey.



As the Apostle Paul comes to the close of his letter to the Philippians, he issues this invitation, "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I will say rejoice!" These words have served as my compass during my time thus far at Immanuel. Paul's words shape and mold me as a follower of Jesus: Rejoice!

I want to offer a sincere thank you to the members of Immanuel! Your kindness and support have been so encouraging to me during this portion of my formation. It is a privilege to work among three talented, caring, and faithful pastors, talented and gracious office staff, and wonderful board members and lay-leaders. I am continually humbled and inspired by the boards and lay-leaders and their involvement and support of the ministry at Immanuel.

The vicarage year is a time to apply what we have learned at the Seminary and in our field work within a concrete context and community. It is also a time for healthy, capable pastors and congregations to teach vicars what will help them be effective in their ministry. During this vicarage year, I am both applying what I've learned and learning from all of you in four specific areas: preaching, teaching, visiting, and administration.

- **Preaching**: Since my first sermon on September 19, my confidence, creativity, and composure in the pulpit has grown as I received constructive feedback and gracious encouragement from the Pastors and the congregation. I am thankful to have the opportunity to work on preparing and delivering meaningful and engaging children's messages, as well. In addition to preaching at Immanuel, I have preached at St. Paul's in Dewberry, Indiana, during chapel at Immanuel and Zion, and recorded devotions for Know Your Bible and Dial-A-Meditation.
- **Teaching**: During this year, I specifically wanted to develop my skills for teaching in the church and school. In the first quarter of the Fall Semester, I taught a Sunday Morning Bible Class on "Savoring the Psalms." The second quarter of the Fall semester, I taught a Sunday Morning Bible Class on Paul's Letter to the Ephesians. During the week, I have taught 8<sup>th</sup> grade confirmation classes for both public school and Immanuel students. Likewise, I have had the delight of teaching the 6/7<sup>th</sup> grade confirmation students online. Throughout the majority of the weeks, I have taught Tuesday Morning Men's Bible Study, "Getting Ready for Sunday Morning," and a monthly "Holy Hops Study" at Poplar Street. Having the opportunity to teach week after week and to find appropriate and helpful ways to differentiate my teaching style and materials for a variety of ages and classes has been a joy.
- **Visiting**: I have had the privilege of visiting with and calling several members of Immanuel that for any number of reasons have been unable to attend weekly church services in person. It these visits, I have witnessed how God opens the hearts and minds of people for me to share God's word of hope and promise for each person, in their unique situation or challenge. These conversations provide unique opportunities for the mutual building up and encouragement of one another.
- Administration: During this year, Immanuel has been pivoting and transitioning, adapting and adjusting. To do this well requires pastors, staff, boards and all members to become a people who are curios, creative, and confident in the promises of Christ. I have had the privilege of putting together a "Glowing in the Dark" Halloween event which was a journey through the Scriptures as told by costumed Biblical characters. I also put together a senior adult's panel conversation on Patriots Day for our service men and women. Sadly, neither of these events took place because of Covid-19, but they are events easily adapted for another time by a future vicar. One of my greatest joys this year was coordinating the live drive-thru nativity on December 11 and 12. Because of the work of many volunteers, our church was able to share the story of Jesus God with us the Savior of the world born to die and rise to reconcile the world back to Himself. That's our story and we were able to share it!

I thank you all for embracing my wife, Charlea and me during this strange year. Because the Triune God is with us and for us, we are a people with a future and a hope. With that *always* in mind, I look forward to what 2021 will bring as your vicar at Immanuel.

## Principal's Report Dr. Todd Behmlander-Principal

Our 2020 calendar year began with our annual Geography Bee. Our school champion for the Geography Bee was Jackson Sutherland and runner-up, Gabriella Parisi. Our Sertoma contest winner in 2020 was sixth grader, Lauren Bode. Claire Hatfield and Eli Tempest were named D.A.R. E. essay contest winners. Our 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys' basketball team won the Indiana/Illinois basketball tournament, and Ben Neawedde was the school spelling bee champion and Lance Hubbard the runner-up. The junior high production of "Frozen" was performed in March.

Immediately following the spring musical "Frozen," our school closed for the remainder of the school year due to the coronavirus. All learning went online, and electronic lessons were taught Tuesdays-Thursdays from the end of March to the end of May. All sports and activities were also canceled for the remainder of the school year. Graduation was postponed until mid-June. It was held in the Immanuel Lutheran Church sanctuary so guests could spread out, and attendance was limited to immediate family only. The valedictorian of the Class of 2020 was Kiley Zabel, and the salutatorian was Katherine Veatch. Immanuel was able to receive Payment Protection Program money to aid cafeteria workers and janitors who were laid off from March to May. We said good-bye to Mrs. Debra Lambert, who taught faithfully at Immanuel since 1982. Mrs. Trisha Engel, second grade teacher, left Immanuel to accept a call as principal at St. John, Sauers. We contracted two new teachers, Mrs. Megan Keller and Miss Cassidy Sawyer.

Much time was spent over the summer to ensure students would be able to return to in-person learning within a safe environment. Desks were separated in classrooms, curtains were hung between desks, individual seating replaced cafeteria tables, doors remained propped open, and parents were asked to only enter the building if necessary. Our 2020/21 school year began like no other. All students and staff wore masks throughout the day, students were always seated alphabetically, and governmental money was used to purchase hand sanitizer and cleaning agents in bulk.

Our 2020/21 theme was ... be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him; bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God. (Col. 1:9-10).

In August, we welcomed 31 first graders and realized an enrollment of 295, a decrease of 11 students from 2019/20. Our parent educational fee rose from \$1,400 to \$1,650 per child and church tuition increased from \$4,423 to \$4,673.

The fish fry was held in the school parking lot and was conducted as a drive-thru. It raised a record-setting \$4,900. The golf outing was canceled; however, the faithful golf committee raised approximately \$17,000 in donations.

During the fall of 2020, changes due to COVID continued. The United States Department of Agriculture offered free lunches to all students regardless of income. Cancellations in Grandparents' Day and the academic fair were realized. The Christmas concert went virtual only, attendance to basketball games was limited, and the children's Christmas Eve services were split into two services by the alphabet, and only immediate family was asked to attend.

While changes due to earthly events can happen quickly from one year to the next, each year we realize God's continued goodness through faithful teachers, dedicated parents, and enthusiastic students at Immanuel Lutheran School. His blessings upon His school were evident before COVID struck and during COVID. He served us with the gift of his Son, and we are privileged to serve Him by sharing his Word each and every day. We thank the members of Immanuel Lutheran Church, who build us up through prayer and encourage us through their gifts.


