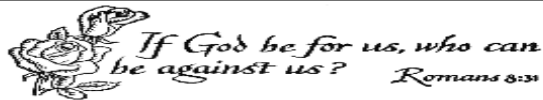
Stained Glass Window Models

In the narthex you will find an artist's rendition of what two of the six new windows for the church are to look like. The voters unanimously approved the Stained Glass Window Project January 27. This project would replace the 6 large bays of windows in the church on the south and north sides with beautiful and insulated stained glass.

The total project budget is \$350,000. This project is scheduled to take 18 months - completion date estimated for June, 2020, in line with the 150th anniversary celebration. Contributions for this beautification project can be made to the ILC Stained Glass Window Fund.
