Goals:

- 1. Students finding satisfaction in honoring God with the best of their abilities
- 2. Using positive, yet honest, reinforcement to encourage musical growth.
- 3. Providing students opportunities to perform outside of the classroom.

Evaluation:

Work Ethic (Goal 1): Students will be expected to follow various instructions in class including home preparation & demonstrating the ability to ask pertinent questions in class. (40% of grade)

<u>Recordings (Goal 2)</u>: Students will be expected to record a given piece once a quarter. Students may record at their home or on the school's recording device. Percussion will be evaluated in class. Extra credit can be earned through extra work (private lessons, solo/ensemble, after school, etc.). (30% of grade) (6-8 only).

<u>Completing Scales or Rudiments (Goal 2)</u>: Students will be asked to complete either scales or rudiments, depending on their instrument. Materials will be given to students in class (20% of grade)

Brass & Woodwind:

•	5 th Grade:	Students will play 3 beginning level major scales.	No Grade
•	6 th Grade:	Students will play 6 major scales of their choice.	(3) by second quarter; (6) by 4 th Quarter
•	7 th Grade:	Students will play 10 major scales of their choice.	(5) by second quarter; (10) by 4^{th} Quarter
•	8 th Grade:	Students will play all 12 major scales.	(6) by second quarter; (12) by 4^{th} Quarter

Percussion:

•	5 th Grade:	Students will perform Group V rudiments.	No Grade
•	6 th Grade:	Students will perform Group IV rudiments.	(2) by second quarter; (4) by 4 th Quarter
•	7 th Grade:	Students will perform Group III rudiments.	(2) by second quarter; (4) by 4 th Quarter
•	8 th Grade:	Students will perform Group II rudiments.	(2) by second quarter; (4) by 4 th Quarter

^{**}Students may complete these scales ahead of time if they wish.
