Window Work Continues

In addition to removing side windows and replacing them with insulated and protective glass, the old hot water radiators and grates have also been removed. These have not been in use since we changed to an HVAC system in 1995 to add air conditioning to the church. Those opening are also being covered with stone or drywall, depending on the location.

The draping on the windows should help shield from the sun until stained glass windows are installed in June. Windows in the sacristy area are also being replaced. Thanks for your patience as the work continues!

Ash Wednesday is Coming!


