- The Laws in the Bible are not a behavior manual, rather it provides principles of living according to God's will and plan, along with examples in the context of ancient Israel.
- The video divides the laws into four categories: holiness, sacrifice, justice, and sacred time.
- Another categorization breaks the laws into moral, ritual, and civil distinctions according to this schema, Christians are only expected to fulfill the moral laws.
- As Christians, we believe that the Law was fulfilled by Jesus. He both kept it perfectly and send us His Spirit to empower us to carry out God's will today.
